Child Care and Education

0-9 years -children from 0 - 9 years are well catered for in the village.

Leigh on Mendip First School (812592) has been declared an 'Outstanding' school by Ofsted (Office for Standards and Education).

It takes children from 4 years to 9 years and links closely with the Owl Babies Pre-school (see below).

The school has 2 classes, a team of experienced staff and combines a caring, family atmosphere, with an excellent range of learning opportunities.

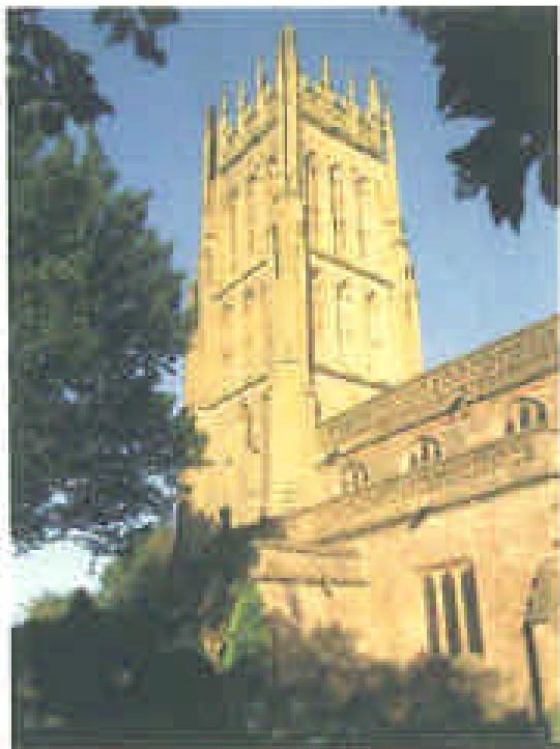
Owl Babies Pre school (from age 2½) is situated on the school site and has been awarded "Outstanding" status by Ofsted. It offers sessions in the mornings and afternoons with lunch session for children wishing to stay all day, Contact 814782.

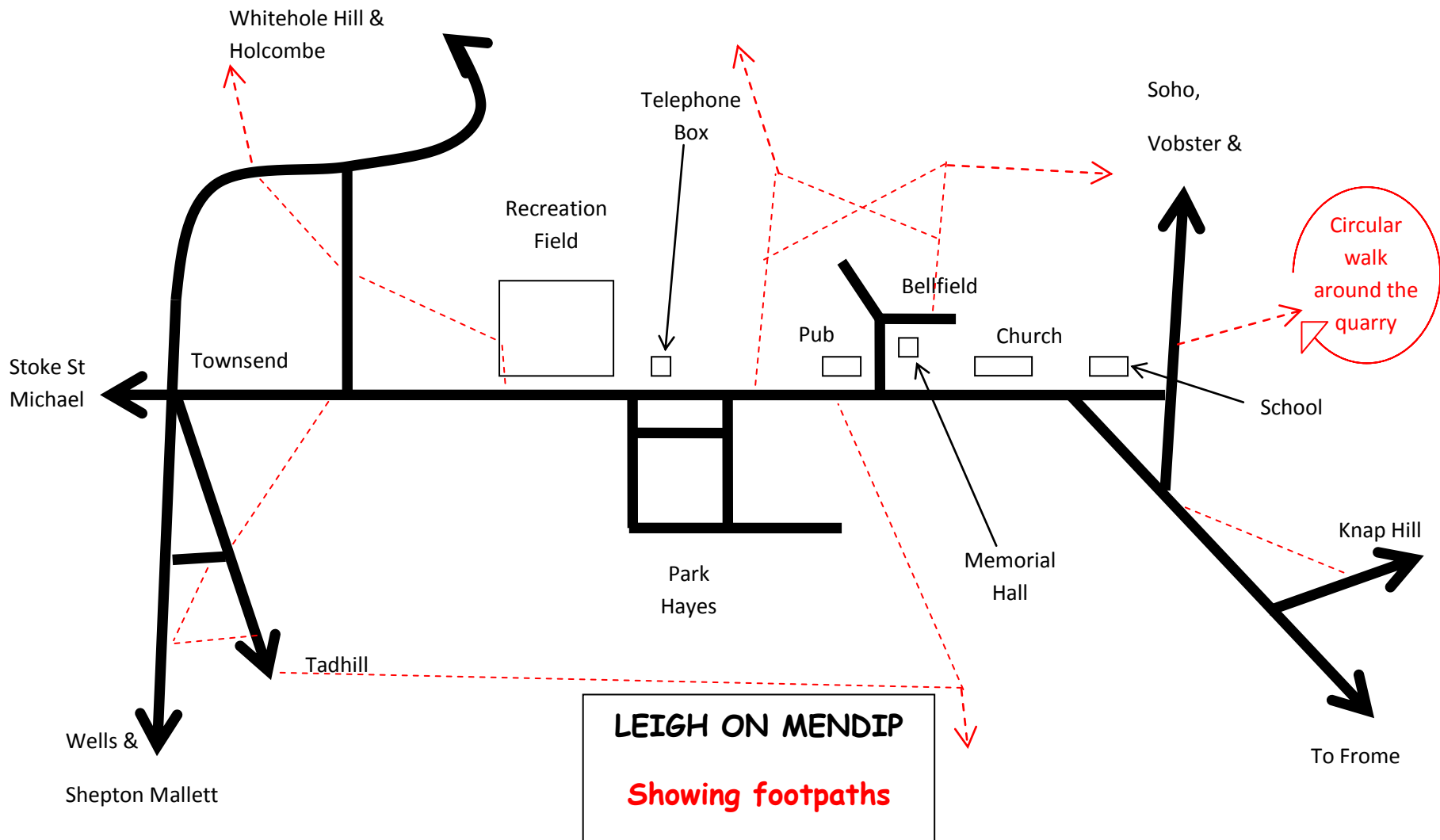
